102	Chateau Haut-Rian (Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc), Graves, Bordeaux, 2011 / Freshly cut hay, grapefruit @ minerals with semillon adding more weight than most sauvignon blancs.		26
103	Pascal Jolivet, "Attitude" (Sauvignon Blanc), Loire, France, 2009 / Classic example of Loire Valley Sauvignon Blanc from famed producer, these are younger vines giving fresh minerality, grass, brisk, clean finish.		39
104	Sutcliffe (Viognier), McElmo Canyon, Colorado, 2011 / Tropical fruits with an emphasis on peaches, nice acidity, one of Colorado's best dry white wines.		40

201	August Kessler (Pinot Noir), Rheingau, Germany, 2008 / Known as 'spatburgunder' (late Burgundy) in Germany, delightfully spicy, red currant @ cinnamon scented.		45
202	Casalfarneto (La Crima di Morro d'Alba), Marches, Italy 2010 / Named 'rosae' for it's distinct aromas of violets, berries @ roses, wonderfully fragrant, lively, light bodied @ fun.		40
203	Austin Hope (Grenache), Paso Robles, California, 2010 / Organically farmed, clones were 'stolen' from perrin unfiltered, baking spices, olive, licorice.		60
204	Nederberg (Pinotage), South Africa, 2010 / A crossing of Pinot Noir @ Cinsault, Pinotage is 'the' grape of South Africa, distinctive medicinal smoky nose, think earthy Pinot Noir.		24
205	Abbazia di Novacella (Lagrein), Alto-Adige, Italy, 2010 / Love this grape from Northern Italy, violets, vanilla, packed with flavor, deceptively full bodied.		42
206	Terradora (Aglanico), Campania, Italy, 2009 / This grape has a precise @ distinct 'volcanic' dustiness coming from the vineyard soils, easy drinking, cherries, raspberries, leather @ licorice.		29
207	Palladino (Barbera d'Alba) "Bricco delle Olive", Piedmont, Italy 2007 / A rare gem of a single vineyard Barbera that sees oak aging, making this well structured with dark fruits @ cracked espresso beans on the nose.		55
208	Sierra Cantabria (Tempranillo), Crianza, Rioja, Spain 2007 / Slightly smoky, raspberries, spice box, graphite, unfiltered, opens up beautifully into a multi-faceted dinner wine.		42
209	Sharecropper's (Cabernet Sauvignon), Yakima Valley, Washington, 2010 / Wines profits are shared evenly with grapes' farmers, hence the name, great, easy drinking, earthy @ slightly herbal.		30
210	Klinker Brick (Zinfandel), Lodi, California, 2009 / 80 year old vines, 5th generation farmers, jammy red fruits.		32
211	Chateau Musar, "Jeune" (Cinsault/Syrah/Cabernet Sauvignon), Lebanon, 2009 / The little brother to the age-worthy powerhouses similar to pinots, with a lot more oomph @ an earthy kick.		45
212	Alma Negra (Malbec/Bonarda), Mendoza, Argentina, 2007 / One of our favorite malbecs with a shot of bonarda to separate it from the masses, blue fruits, silky texture.		49
213	North Star (Merlot), Columbia Valley, Washington, 2007 / Soft pretty nose of black fruits, lavender.		55
214	Rotlan Torra, Semi Crianza (Grenache/Carignan/Cabernet Sauvignon), Priorat, Spain, 2007 / Planted on licorella (tiger stripe) slatey soils, big fruit concentration with focused acidity @ a long finish.		35
215	Churchills (Douro Red), Douro, Portugal, 2008 / Broody, chocolate, pepper @ cedar.		30
